AVILA COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, EDACOCHIN, COCHIN STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY - 2022-2023

This report reveals the results and evaluation from the Avila College of Education Student Opinion Survey, which was conducted to gain comprehensive insights into various aspects of students' college experience. It was conducted among student teachers who completed B.Ed. programme during the academic year 2022-23. The survey concentrated on significant areas, including academic contentment, institutional assistance, and campus involvement, while also soliciting feedback and suggestions. Students were provided with a rating scale that ranged from excellent to poor. The objective of this survey was to gauge students' viewpoints and collect valuable recommendations to improve the educational standards and support services at Avila College of Education.

The survey explored the students' satisfaction and contentment with their academic pursuits at Avila College, examining factors such as the competence of instruction from faculty, contentment with resources and facilities, the correlation of courses with academic and career objectives, accessibility of academic guidance, and the cost of educational materials. Additionally, the survey gathered data on the support services offered by the college, including counseling, communication effectiveness between faculty/staff and students, and the institution's responsiveness to student feedback and concerns. Furthermore, the survey investigated students' involvement in extracurricular activities, participation in student organizations, overall satisfaction with their college experience, and willingness to recommend Avila College to others. These insights aimed to understand campus life and engagement opportunities. Lastly, students were provided with a platform to share their feedback and suggestions for improving their college experience. This section allowed students to express their opinions on areas needing improvement and contribute to enhancing institutional practices.

The findings from the survey have been analysed, and the results are outlined in the subsequent sections of this report. The insights and recommendations derived from this survey are aimed at offering guidance and suggestions for initiatives aimed at improving the overall student experience at Avila College.





1. How satisfied are you with your academic experience at Avila College?




2. How would you rate the quality of teaching provided by your teachers?



3. How satisfied are you with the resources and facilities available on campus?






4. How satisfied are you with the accessibility and availability of academic advisors and support staff?




5. To what extent do you feel the courses offered align with your academic and career goals?



6. How satisfied are you with the opportunities for internships, co-op programs, or practical experience related to your field of study?





1. How would you rate the support services offered by the institution (e.g., counselling)?




2. How would you rate the communication between faculty/staff and students?







3. To what extent do you feel your feedback and concerns are listened to and addressed by the institution?



1. How satisfied are you with the extracurricular activities and student organizations available?




2. How likely are you to recommend Avila College to a friend or family member?

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

The analysis of data gathered from students provides a comprehensive view of student satisfaction across various aspects of their academic experiences in the institution. In terms of academic experience and satisfaction, 51.28% of respondents rated their overall satisfaction as Excellent, while 48.72% rated it as Good. This indicates a positive perception of the overall academic environment, including the quality of teaching, alignment of courses with academic and career goals, and accessibility of academic advisors. However, there are areas for improvement, such as enhancing resources and facilities satisfaction, with 56.41% rating it as Good but 33.33% rating it as Satisfactory, and ensuring affordability and accessibility of educational resources like textbooks and course materials, where 53.85% rated it as Good and 41.03% rated it as Excellent.

Institutional support and services received a generally positive response, with 53.85% rating support services as Good and 28.21% rating it as Excellent. Communication between faculty/staff and students was rated as Good by 56.41% of respondents. The handling of feedback and concerns also garnered positive feedback, with 48.72% feeling that their feedback and concerns are listened to and addressed by the institution.

Regarding campus life and engagement, while there was satisfaction with the overall student life experience (53.85% rated it as Excellent) and a likelihood to recommend Avila College to others (51.28%), there were mixed responses regarding satisfaction with extracurricular activities and student organizations. 46.15% rated extracurricular activities as Good, indicating room for improvement and diversification to cater to a broader range of student interests and engagement levels. Overall, the survey highlights areas of strength and

areas for growth, providing valuable insights for on-going improvements in enhancing the overall student experience at Avila College.

SUGGESTIONS

Some suggestions for improvement were indicated by students in the survey. They are:

- Enhance Resources and Facilities: This could involve investing in upgraded facilities, ensuring sufficient resources for academic purposes, and improving accessibility to resources like textbooks and course materials.
- Improve Communication and Feedback Channels: This may include regular updates on college events, academic policies, and resources through multiple communication platforms.
- Monitor Affordability and Accessibility of Educational Resources: Explore options
 for reducing the financial burden of textbooks and course materials, such as digital
 resources, library access, or subsidized programmes.
- Include more field trips to sustain the interest of the student teachers as well as to reduce their work pressure and academic stress.
